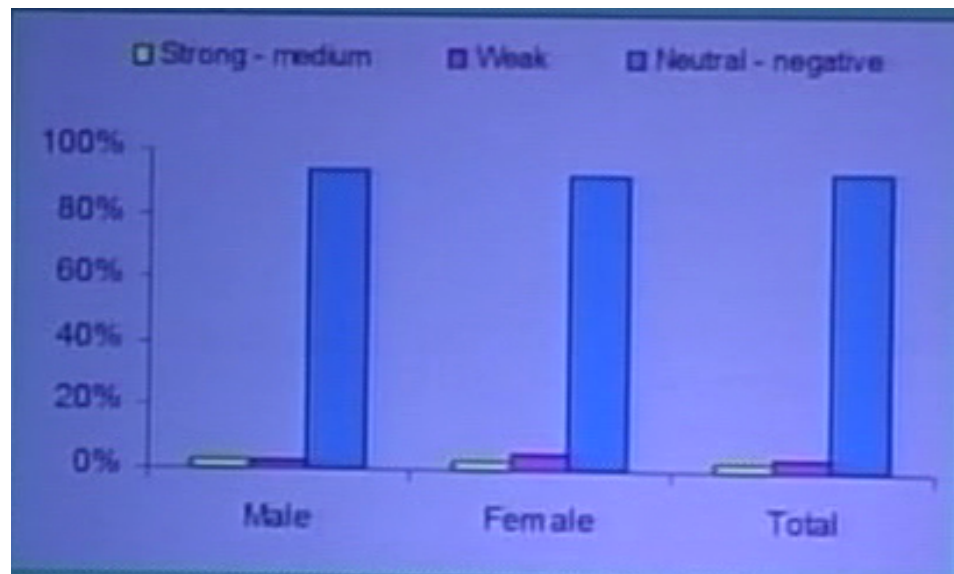

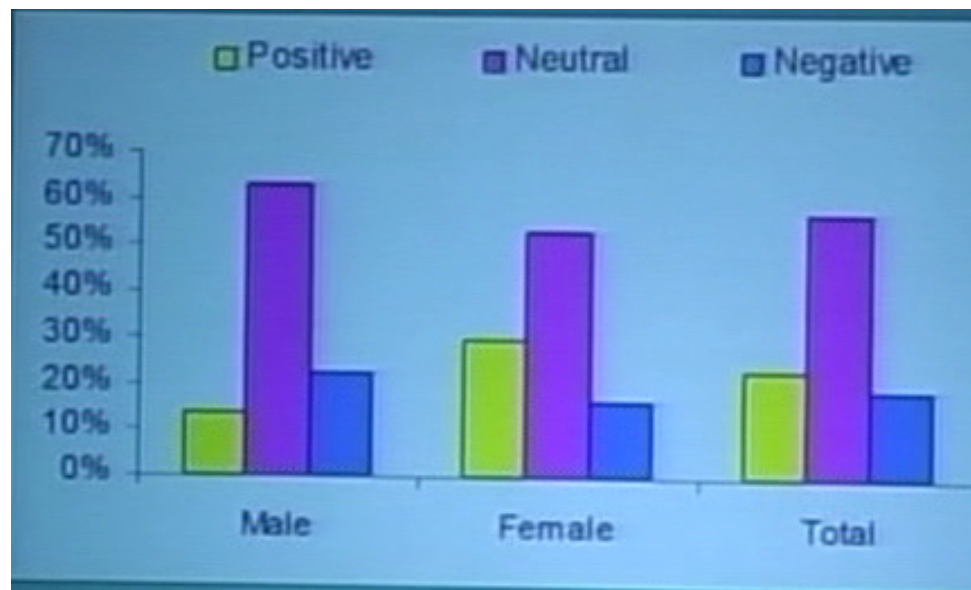

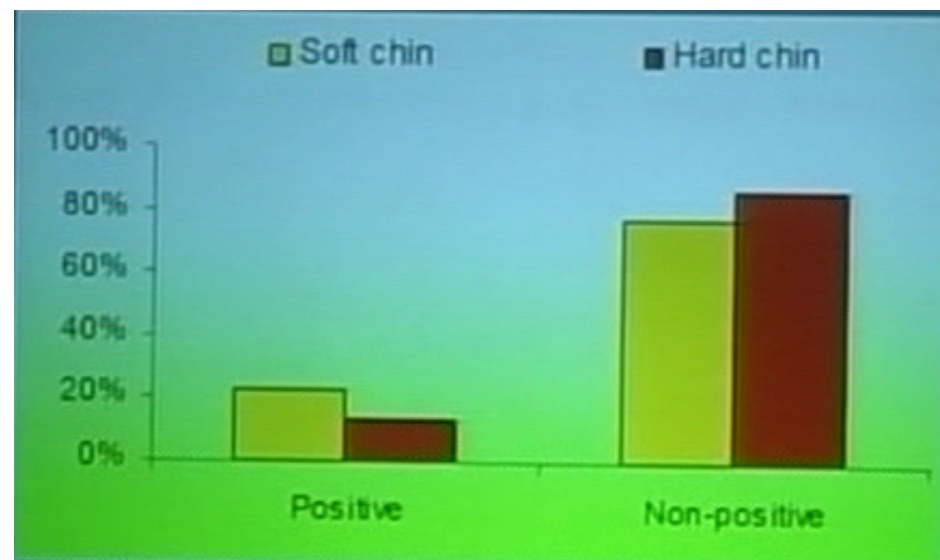

Positive and Non-Positive Chin Projection Rampasasa Population (2007)

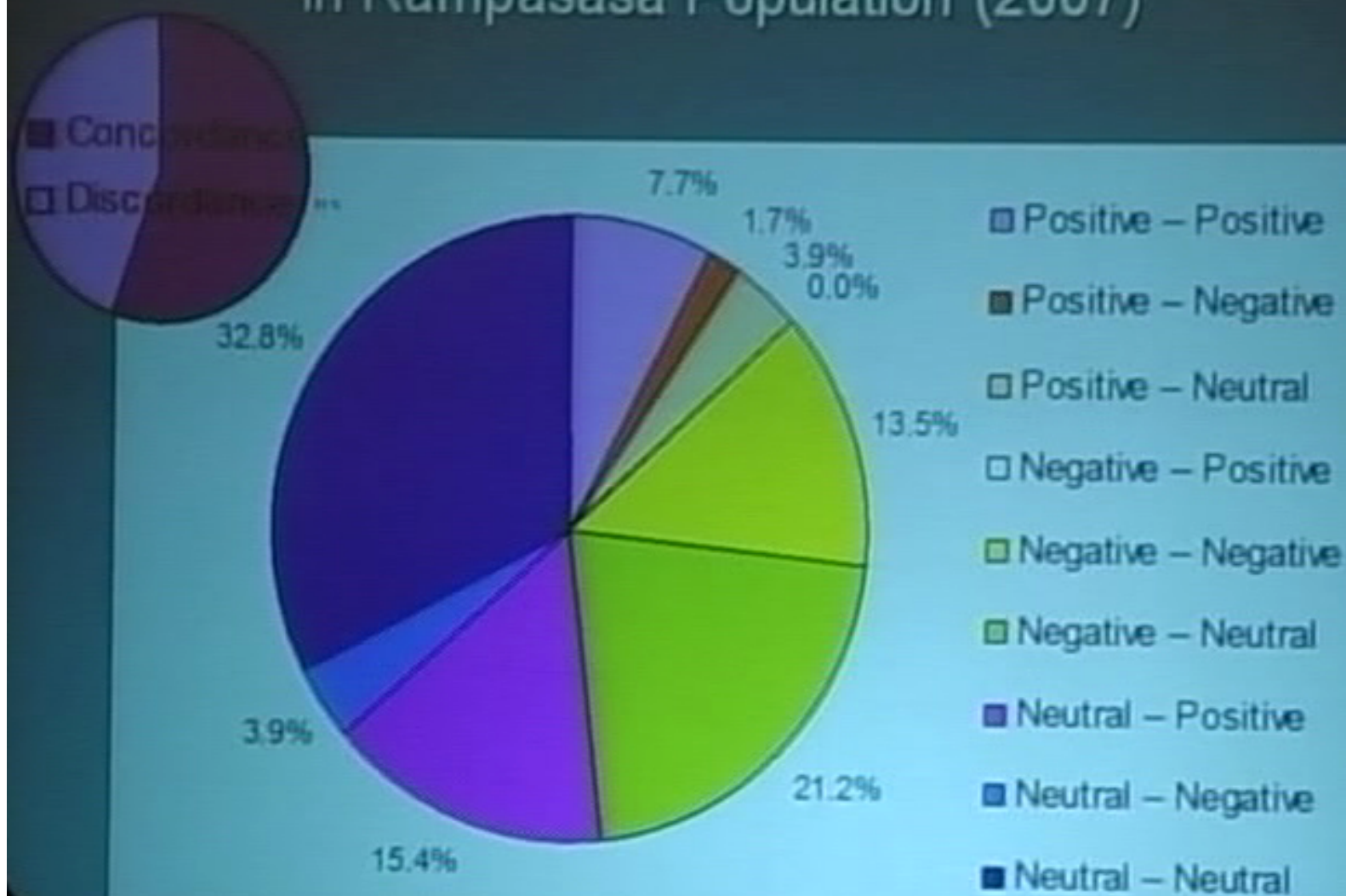

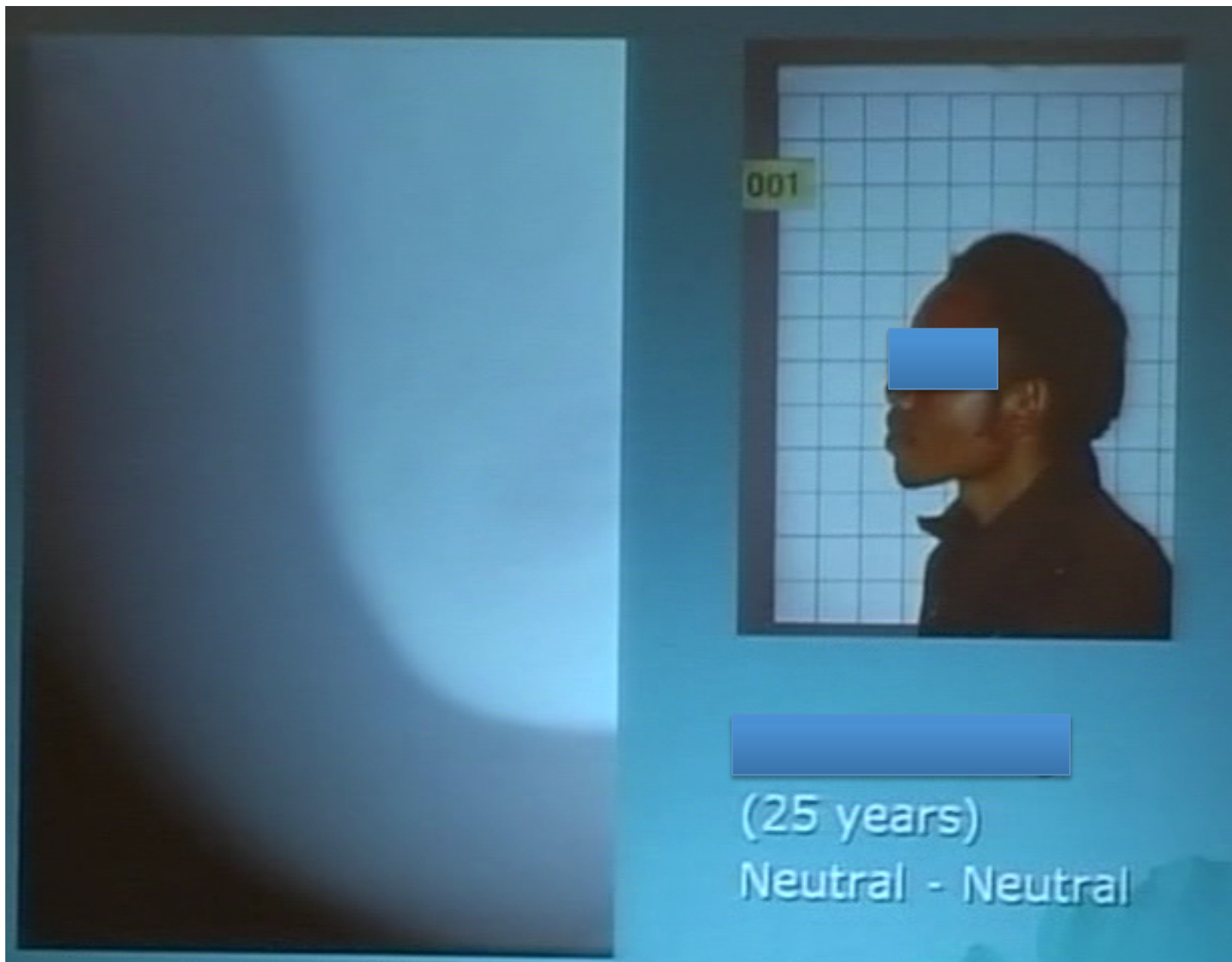

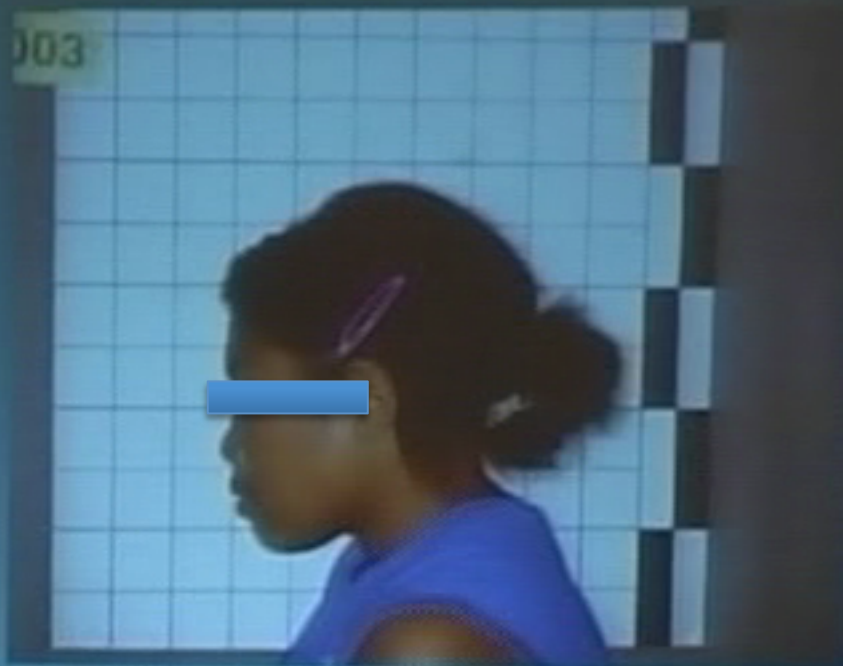
Concordance Between Soft and Hard Chin in Rampasasa Population (2007)

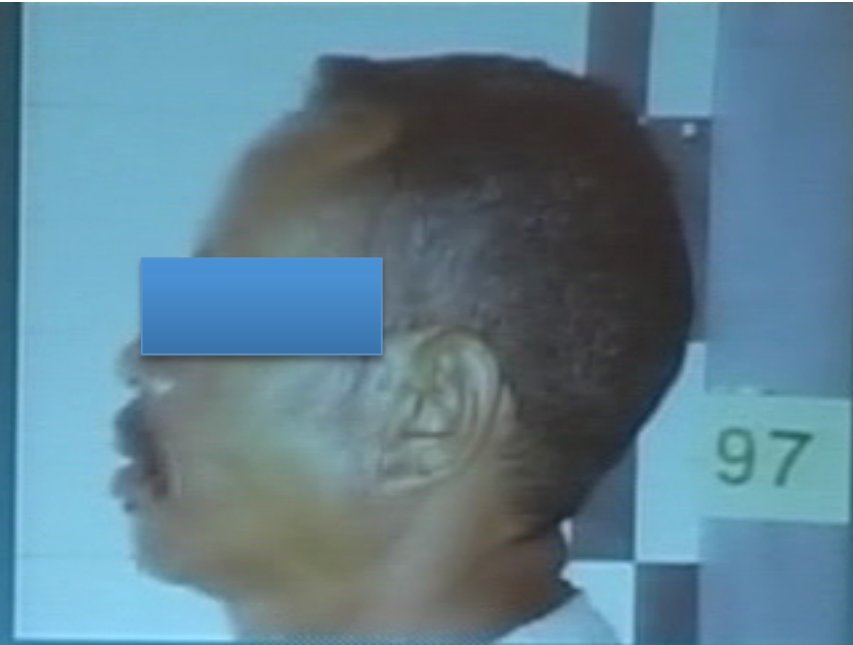

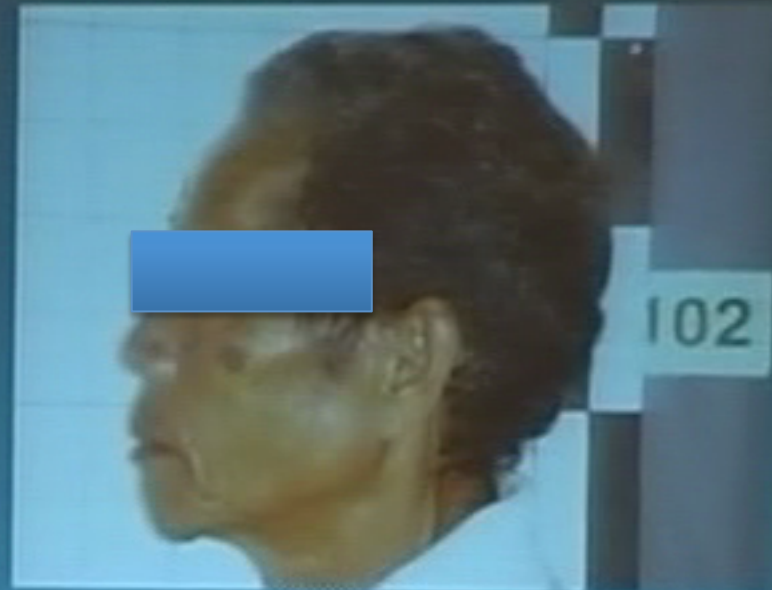

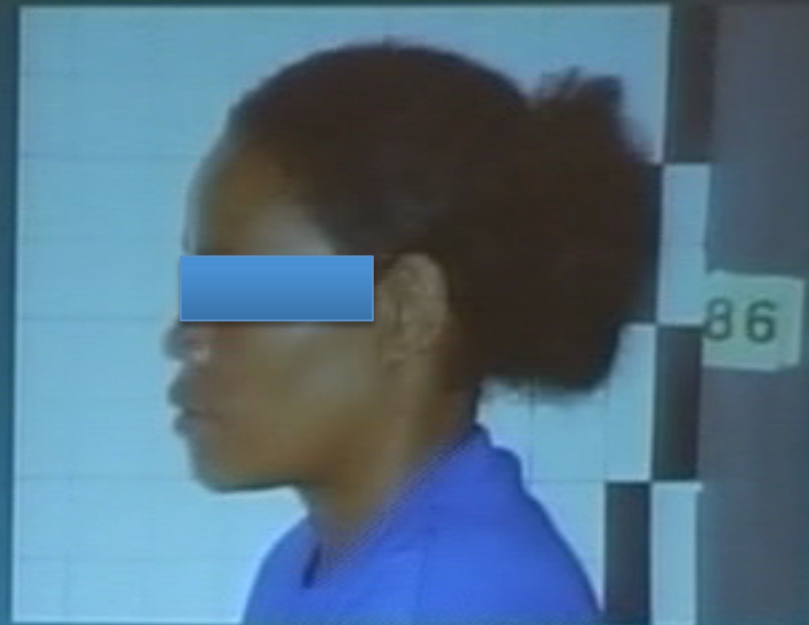
